Everything always works out in the end. If it hasn't worked out yet, it's not the end! Earlier this year Edward P. Dietrich donated \$5,000 to the Deerfield Beach Historical Society with one small catch, it was presented with a challenge. The challenge to the Society: raise matching funds of \$5,000. Ed, who now resides in North Carolina, is a long time Deerfield Beach resident,

charter Historical Society member, Kiwanis Club member and founder of Deerfield Builders Supply which operated in Deerfield Beach for over 66 years. Over the past few months, matching donations both large and small have been pushing us towards the \$5000 goal. Many people have taken advantage of the 40th Anniversary special dues of \$20 and added \$20, \$50 or \$100 extra. Last week, an

anonymous donation (unmarked envelope, cryptic message, bank desk check) arrived in the Society's mail box. This very generous \$1,000 donation pushed us over the top!

The Society also received an anonymous donation of \$500 last month, generous donations from David Eller and Kiwanis of DFB and to kick off the fundraiser, a \$500 donation from board member and volunteer, Ron LaVergne. The Historical Society oversees four properties in Deerfield Beach that are on the National Register of Historic Places. They are the
